WHAT WE DO:

The most important thing the **San Diego Homeless Board**, a group of homeless who help other homeless, does is to bring a little bit of organization into the process of homeless advocacy. Editorials, education, suggestions, applicable laws, solutions, things to back, called shots in the political process.

We also operate **HEN, the Homeless Emergency Network**, at [Twitter.Com/NZ9F](https://twitter.com/NZ9F), which is a Twitter page that sends out tweets when an emergency occurs. Could be a virus, an uprising, any emergency. Once a month (average) the system is tested, sending out a message that the San Diego Homeless News has just published another edition. There are no other tweets. A new edition, or a dire emergency, and nothing else.

We expose the causes of homelessness, correcting lies told in the news media. We evaluate solutions to the homeless problem, evaluated from the perspective of the homeless ourselves, a factor not usually included by governments nor nonprofits. Once people are homeless, they **then begin** to become alcoholics, dope addicts, and mentally ill, and then society has more problems to deal with than just housing.

If you were a former Police Chief, Engineer, Editor, and Activist with a Ph.D. in Psychology, what would you do to help solve San Diego's homeless problem? We have a website at NZ9F.com, two newspapers, and other services. Our other newspaper is called "Homeless City News" and comes out only on paper. We have a wire service that goes to the national news media. We started locally by printing the times and locations of the food pantries and free meals. We forced the upgrade of County 211 by having a better information service than theirs, once upon a time. We constantly publish solutions on how to get a more accurate homeless count, how to inexpensively minimize the homeless problem, and how to arrive at low-cost permanent solutions. We consistently expose the secret societies that black-ball homeless and political dissidents, plus inform the public exactly what these secret agencies are up to, especially things being done that are illegal and violent.

Our **anti-suicide program** features a lot of poverty-related humor on our website, plus a program that helps military veterans find great sex in Tijuana, if they are in danger of suicide. NZ9F.com/humor. Impossible to kill yourself while laughing your ass off.

The design of this newspaper, and its layout, goes like this: First a **General Editorial** (second item in the newspaper) is written in advance, about a recurring problem, canned. ("Canned" means we have a selection of these on the shelf and just pick one.) Then an **editorial on solutions proposed** and political things that could help, especially if they contradict the "Conventional Wisdom" of the FAKE studies done by universities on the homeless problem. There is usually also an **article on Gnosis** (Spirituality), the process of both socialization and brainwashing used to cause the homeless to obey and eventually commit suicide. There is usually one article on getting an education in **the truth about homelessness**. There may be a **cartoon**, there is certainly a section on **News Media News**, and the issue ends with **Comic Relief** in the form of the Snide Comments section. The last thing completed in each edition is the **Lead Editorial**, which complains about whatever is the biggest current problem. It gets first position.

LEAD EDITORIAL, NORMALLY THE FIRST ARTICLE:

SOLUTIONS:

We usually begin an edition with the biggest problems and most pessimistic analysis, and then move into the smaller and more chronic problems, finally suggesting solutions. I (John Kitchin) have to take the credit or blame for it all, because **intelligent homeless who help with this newspaper refuse to be identified**. They want to someday have housing and employment. Or, they want to not lose their present housing and employment. We know all about the secret "Conspiracy Theory" groups that own and run everything, forming the power structure which controls society. Most of them are Cabals, also known as Gnosis or Gnostic Groups, plus there are even Halal Groups. These folks control people by putting their blood and semen in the foods that everybody eats, and also Holy Communion. **This also causes many to become addicted to alcohol or drugs, and the process of eating the DNA of other people causes mental illness, too.** I do not write this entire newspaper, but must take the credit or blame for all that is in it. Today we begin with Solutions and Optimism, the reverse of our normal order. Article:

Editorialists who do not suggest solutions are like politicians who do not accept responsibility for their actions and decisions. In other words, they're everywhere. Had we unlimited power, we would force real solutions to San Diego's homeless problems. Not just powerful labor unions and a tax on vacant housing, but also homeless campgrounds, villages, and transportation systems. Because we suggested it, there are a few free campgrounds for the homeless, but all methods of separating the homeless from the rest of society bear the problem of transportation. How do they get to the Father Joe's Villages San Diego County free meal every day for example?

GRANNY FLATS

Besides campgrounds, we envision Granny Flats to also be a solution. 10,000 homeowners volunteer to have 3 apartments each added to their homes by a

nonprofit construction firm. These 3 apartments per home would be designed to rent for the current going rate, or \$1,700 per month each, a total income of \$5,100 per month. This is \$61,200 per year. When the apartments are constructed, they will be occupied by HUD families under their programs, all revenues going to repay construction costs. Once those costs are paid, any revenues and tenants are retirement income for the homeowner, more than \$1,250 a week. The result is that 30,000 apartments are created which could house San Diego's 32,000 homeless. This would produce a major dent into San Diego's homeless problem, using diverse areas, because it would free up Working Class housing that is currently occupied by the Middle Class because of San Diego having no Middle Class housing available at all. The Middle Class moves into the Granny Flats, moving out of Lower Class housing, and the Working/Lower Class gets those apartments becoming vacated. What is also likely to happen is that many persons currently homeless will soon be able to afford the \$1,700 a month going rate for the cheapest housing, due to unionization of jobs in San Diego. That fixes the whole enchilada and at no taxpayer expense. Zoning, permitting, application fees and all that may need a few changes or streamlining, but that is a political thing, not an expense.

AFFORDABLE HOUSING

This Middle Class housing is the HUD mis-named "Affordable Housing" that San Diego lacks. **"Affordable Housing" is for millionaires who are not billionaires.** It is "Affordable" for a Professional. If there are plans to build "Affordable Housing" next door to you, expect your new neighbors to be dentists, surgeons, Marine Corps Colonels, corporate executives, attorneys, that sort of thing. It is way too expensive for a dishwasher, cook, taxi driver, manicurist, street sweeper, or domestic servant. The problem with "Affordable Housing" is the ridiculous name attached to it. It's like the "Massively Huge Gigantic Big Size" laundry detergent that turns out to be a tiny box. Companies and governments play games with words to make things seem like something other than what they are. Affordable Housing is designed for incomes of \$28 an hour, but because of Inflation, that figure is currently more like \$35 an hour. Less income than that, you cannot fill out an application to live there. Got it? HUD, with the cooperation of the News Media has folks thinking that "Affordable Housing" is for poor people. Nope. It should be called "Affordable For Professionals", because that is what it is.

TINY HOUSES

Another plan worth merit is to build either a shack or a Tiny Home (Amikas.Org) that is low-cost, say under \$2,000 for each one built. I propose a no-frills shack be built for each homeless person, to be used both for sleeping and possessions storage. It would have no windows and a secure door, for security, and would have a skylight for sunlight in the daytime and street-light light at night. Each shack has a parking space next to it so that the occupant can park their car there and run 12-volt items (such as charging a computer or cell phone) using the car battery. To be arranged are toilets, showers, trash pickup, security, and transportation. Food? Transportation to the Father Joe's San Diego County daily meal and the food pantries, or perhaps Meals-On-Wheels.

CAMPGROUNDS

We also need more overnight campgrounds for RVs, of course, provided folks can prove they have lived in San Diego the past 10 years solid, and worked and paid taxes at least 5 of those past ten years. No new visitors get this "vacation" option. Social Security records could prove these things, with permission from the persons involved.

REASONS AND COSTS

We need to solve the homeless problem because it is interfering with tourism, banking, investment, retail sales, prestige, real estate rental and sales, entrepreneurship, cleanliness, health, and safety. All those things resulting just from a lack of housing! Limit the cost to \$2,000 per person housed, because the current cost of \$300,000 per person housed is prohibitive. Yes it could be done for \$10 billion, and the downtown condo sales industry nets \$1 billion per week, while causing homeless at the same time. Let us remember that Clairemont and Bay Ho were both projects for San Diego's poor and homeless, years ago.

HELPFUL RULES CHANGES

Changing the rules for HUD and CRUD (Cronies Ruining Urban Development, HEAP) funding could help, too, by forcing all of the money to be used only for renting or construction of housing. No money used for non-construction labor, such as housing navigators, computer specialists, counselors, case workers, psychologists, etc. You can use the money for the labor of an electrician, bricklayer, plumber, roofer, or carpenter. Also, all of the housing built must be apartments, not institutions, jails, hospitals, clinics, etc. This would force useful spending of the money, as opposed to useless "Jobs For Relatives of Politicians" spending, which creates no new housing. No money for nonprofits, unless they use all of it to build housing, such as Habitat For Humanity.

HOUSING FIRST OR HOUSING ONLY?

We have a huge homeless problem because we spend money on anything but real housing. And, when we spend money on "housing" it is not actually housing, but institutions like mental hospitals. We just call it housing. This money is to be spent on building and/or renting privately-owned apartments that are not affiliated with any nonprofit organization nor any religion. We need to go from Housing First to Housing Only. We helped force Housing First because it at least went halfway. Time to close the loopholes.

HISTORY OF STUBBORN BELIEFS

In Pagan Theology, angel Yahweh Gabriel (Moroni), (an alien from the culture that Mars had over a million years ago), went halfway when talking to Moses. The Jews at that time believed in many gods, and Moroni tried to tell Moses that there are no gods, nor any God, but Moses could not believe that. So the angel combined all the gods into one single "God" that was an invisible spirit. Moses then demanded to know the name of God, but since God does not exist, God has no name. So Yahweh Gabriel (Moroni) gave Moses his own first name, Yahweh, for the name of God, but told him to shut up about it. Never speak the name of God, which is something we Pagans share with Judaism.

Christians and Jews have proverbs, too. The same angel sold the Buddhists the complete truth of there being zero gods or Gods. CRUCIFY HUD?

If we cannot reform HUD, then we must put it out of business, but that would cause extreme hardship. In any case Redevelopment, real estate greed, and government corruption caused rampant homelessness and forced expensive solutions.

LAST RESORT DESTRUCTIVE SOLUTIONS

There is another way, however, which is to bring the cost of renting real estate low enough, plus wages high enough, that people can just rent whatever housing is available. This would happen if people were to abandon their condos and apartments and

move out of San Diego, crashing real estate like was once done in Las Vegas. Banks went bankrupt, but the market equaled out. Helping average people stay out of San Diego could be accomplished by telling the truth about it being an awful place to live, and emphasizing all the tourist-killings and gun-happy police stories censored out of the national media. Condos are not selling very well right now, and a "Help Bankrupt San Diego" plan might work to make housing less expensive. Either bankrupting San Diego and San Diegans or bankrupting the banks and real estate businesses would be extremely messy, but a viable alternative if no other homeless abatement method, such as Housing Only, works.

BANKRUPT THE CULPRITS?

The Bankruptcy Plan would encourage the boycott of those businesses which cause homelessness, which are coincidentally the same businesses invested in by President Trump and the personal investments of the leaders of the Mormon Church. I wrote an article on that months ago. We will be preparing a Boycott List, so that you, an average citizen, can help end homelessness in San Diego. We will also tell you which competitor's products to buy. Guerilla Warfare, or gorilla warfare? Since San Diego and the Mormon Mafia which runs it care nothing about anything but money, re-channeling money is the answer to the problem.

Solutions to Less-Important Issues

Homeless Choir? Choirs victimize and brainwash people into religious beliefs, further victimizing them. I am a major victim of a Jesuit Roman Catholic choir, and write about that at NZ9F.com/Gesu. Instead, how about a Homeless Rock Band that sings both protest music and rap? All choirs victimize homeless.

Showers? Yes, but downtown, downtown, downtown. Also Mission Valley, El Cajon City, Ocean Beach, Pacific Beach, and most importantly, nowhere else. Unless the homeless ask for them at some other place, after those places listed have showers.

Homeless Storage? Yes, in Kearny Mesa, La Jolla, Pacific and Ocean Beaches, Midway-Three Points, More storage Downtown, Old Town, Mission Valley, think west. The new Housing Navigation Center could be used for additional storage, on 13th and Imperial. They should also have temporary check-in of possessions, so that people can use the library.

HOT (Homeless Outreach Team) should be part of the Fire Dept., not the Police Dept., because every homeless person has seen police somewhere kill one of them for no reason whatsoever. How much respect or cooperation does that produce?

Homeless Art? Okay, watercolor paintings sold at local businesses would be cheap and fine. Maybe also at a silent auction. Forget about outdoor art, though, because it is anti-radical. Homeless Art needs to have a component of poking fun at society, promoting radical change, maybe saying "Fuck You" to rich people. Keep it relevant.

Street Cleanups? Bad idea, unless it gets publicity in the news media. Clean streets mean higher rent prices and more homeless.

Voter Registration? Definitely. Plan A was to get a million homeless to move to San Diego and register all of them to vote.

Unionization? Organizing? Yes, a very important process. We need pickets, marches, protests, parades, demonstrations and the circulation of referendums for ACLU. Now that we have fair elections in San Diego, anything can happen, even getting rich folks to pay their fair share of taxes, which is 100%. Register all homeless to vote, plus get them all into labor unions. Picket banks, handing out flyers that advertise Credit Unions.

TAX CHANGES?

Sure, how about a real estate tax that replaces the sales and use tax? It will never happen, because San Diego is so corrupt that it makes New Jersey look like a Boy Scout camp, by comparison. If you oppose the Mormon Godfather in court, expect that your lawyer will probably be found dead in a back alley, an apparent suicide despite several bullet holes in his or her body. NEWS MEDIA NEWS:

I made the front page of the San Diego Union-Tribune, courtesy of Gary Warth, on Wednesday, Jan. 23, 2019, Page A-1. In case you didn't notice, I did not grovel for donations, like most service providers do when being interviewed by the press. I have been struggling to get back to everybody who saw the article and contacted me, and that, along with the death of my father the same day (see Obituary), delayed this edition. Warth gets it 90% right, and that is better than I could do interviewing him, biographical stories being tough, especially about folks with as convoluted lives as I have had.

The main problem documenting things from the 1960's and 1970's is that there was no internet. Most of what I wrote, for example, exists and existed only as ink on paper, and never made it into the web.

I founded **Milwaukee Alarm Co.** on Dec. 2, 1970, and my attorney was Emmanuel N. Rotter who filed the papers. In 1978 (approx.) I sold the name, my customers, my contracts, and most importantly the alarm equipment in the homes and businesses of my customers to John Black of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints, the Mormons. I did not sell the company as a going business because that would have caused me tax problems with the IRS. In all my life, everything has an asterisk, and you are currently reading one of those right here. By the way, when I wrote for Johnny Carson I was 13 years old and did it by postal mail.

The **San Diego Reader** printed my reply to some of their material, and it was a great editorial. The Reader and I have lampooned each other for years, so they called my letter "Mentally Homeless". Gary Warth has an excellent article, Sunday, Jan. 6, about homeless life expectancy being over 30 years less than for average people. Homeless live 43 years (females) or 47 years (males) on the average, compared with averages up to 82 years for non-homeless. This is a maximum of 39 years difference. Warth, whom I met for the first time 3 days before this article was published, went into the life histories of many San Diego homeless who died, and proved that a whole lot of knowledge, creativity, abilities, training, and worthwhile people were lost. What Warth did not mention, and Mainstream Journalists are not usually permitted to write, is that likely all of the homeless deaths were the result of **losing the will to live**. Hence, there is the Underground Press filling in that blank. What is immediately needed is to have hot showers and flush toilets, 24/7 at the Neil Good Center and at other locations downtown. <https://www.sandiegouniontribune.com/news/homeless-ness/sd-me-homeless-deaths-20180106-story.html>

The other thing that the mainstream press are usually not permitted to print is that the 111 homeless who died in 2018 are probably only one-half or one-third of the real number, because people who die and are homeless are usually not identified as being homeless. At least 15,000 homeless San Diegans are on no homeless list nor count at all. When we die we are registered as a death, but not the death of a homeless person.

Gary Warth has another excellent article in the SD U-T Jan. 25, detailing just how police are used to force an under-count of homeless, which has been happening for years. The article also speaks of how the new use of heat-sensitive drone cameras can now reveal the body heat of those concealed. Our count of San Diego Homeless goes like this:

17,500 people reported their being homeless to the Regional Task Force in 2017, the most recent info available on that. Another 2,600 were not counted but found in jail. That is 20,100 homeless that can be proven. Everyone had to give their photo, Social Security number, and a lot more data to prevent duplicates. We estimate that there were also another 15,000 homeless who refused to give their personal data, to avoid being added to black-ball lists used to deny people decent housing and decent employment for life. These are San Diego's "intelligent" homeless, and they will not be interviewed, nor admit being homeless at all. Because of continuing Redevelopment, tearing down all the inexpensive housing, our 20,000 provable homeless plus 15,000 not provable, is now 1,000 more (accounting for 2018) or 36,000 homeless in San Diego County. So, last year's January 2018 count counted 25% of the actual number of homeless,

at 9,000 counted. We hope this year will be more accurate.

Hello John Kitchin,

My son grew up in North County San Diego. He is now 28 and is homeless. He is an addict and his name is John. He lives in a tent near the Carlsbad mall on El Camino Real. The police are always arresting him for encampment, i.e. sleeping in a tent on public property. He is then given a ticket which he can't pay and then it goes to warrant and then he goes to jail. He has thousands of dollars in fines from encampment charges. He hasn't paid the fines so they turn it over to the IRS and they add penalties. I think that Carlsbad and Vista treat their homeless population badly. The fines can be up to \$500 for encampment. How are homeless people going to pay that? They can't so the debts pile up and if they try and find housing their credit is too bad to qualify. We've heard a lot about the San Diego city homeless because of the hepatitis outbreak but the county homeless aren't getting the help they need.

The **Basic Dignity Coalition (BDC)** met Monday, Jan. 3, with 20 present, including 3 attorneys, 4 homeless, and 3 Journalists. Emily Howe is the new Executive Director, and per usual the meeting was at the Moniker Warehouse, just north of 16th and G. • Current business is that Think Dignity, which operates the BDC, is continuing with a Street Boutique that distributes needed hygiene items; a Street Café, which gives out free food; and Fresh Start Showers, a program that provides showers for San Diego homeless. They also operate the East Village storage program for homeless possessions. • Currently, items related to hygiene are being collected for

Central American Immigrants, San Diego's latest homeless group. • The BDC helps identify issues that can maybe be resolved, and there were 3 suggestions for Think Dignity which surfaced. We need hot showers and flush toilets downtown, via the re-opening of the Neil Good Center on 17th St. We also need to Unionize San Diego. And, we need to get the Encroachment Ordinance thrown out. • San Diego County is sitting on \$2.2 billion in money earmarked for poverty and homeless programs. • For further information, ThinkDignity.Org, and you can see listings of their shower schedules and other services mentioned above. ♦♦♦♦♦
