**Measure L would lock up homeless in private prisons via GEO Continuum of Care Group**, convicted of many human rights abuses. Voice of San Diego, Oct. 17, Andrea Guerrero. Submitted by an anonymous journalist.

**Food Stamps:** Those on SSI can now also get Cal-Fresh (food stamps) on EBT-Food. See your County or State Health and Human Services worker, NOT the Social Security office of the federal government.

**Arson:** Los Angeles homeless camps were destroyed by Arson fires, but only one homeless camp in San Diego got destroyed by Arson this year. Some years as many as ten San Diego homeless camps were burned in a three-hour period. Arson against the homeless risks burning housing in the area, and so should be avoided. It also risks having the homeless find out who the arsonist is, and burning their home. Homeless use cell phone video, recording continuously, to protect camps. Since this article was written, there were at least five more Arson fires at SD homeless camps.

**Vouchers:** Landlords who refuse to accept housing vouchers are now being sued by attorney Christian Curry of the Tenants Legal Center. Voice of San Diego, Oct. 25. No byline.

**Mayoral Race:** Per Voice of San Diego, Oct. 18, Morning Edition, **Barbara Bry** has expressed that homelessness is NOT a housing problem. **Ms. Bry, homelessness is ONLY-ONLY a housing problem**, but if allowed to fester becomes over a thousand additional problems such as trash, pee, poop, smell, loss of investment capital, reduced property values, starvation, diseases, rats, alcoholism, drug use and dope pushers, mental illness, and many more problems. **All of these result from a single issue, a housing problem on the low-cost end.** If you do not fix this one problem, housing, you get a thousand problems automatically. You are not intelligent enough to be Mayor.

Lamb quotes Mayoral candidate Barbara Bry as saying "nearly 9,000 SRO units were demolished in the last decade." Wendy DeWitt, of the San Diego Housing Commission claims it's only 3,000 units. The truth?

The State of California has required San Diego to admit how much low-cost rental housing it has torn down, and the latest city disclosure that I have was 14,500 a few years back. A state investigation made that number 39,500. The news media reported 26,000, and everybody argued about what "low income" means and all definitions were challenged. **Here is the beauty: San Diego tore down 39,500 low-rent housing units the past 24 years and now has almost exactly 39,500 homeless. You just can't make up coincidences like that.**

**Editorial: Expanding the Convention Center.** Convention Centers lose money, but bring in people who spend money on hotels, restaurants, and other tourism services. Currently, cities have so much competition for conventions that nobody is really making money. Since the city does not admit 40,000 homeless, does not admit 1,000 new homeless per year for 15 years, and the new plan only builds 5,000 new units, it must fail. It has good points, but get real!

**New housing money** from the State of California will be wasted the same way San Diego has always wasted money on its homeless problem. More people will be hired to "Outreach" our homeless, even though most of them have been outreached one thousand times or more, each. We need pepper spray or security guards to keep these people away who are interfering with our right to live on the sidewalk, right? No?

In addition to spending more money on harassment, additional Useless, Worthless, and Incompetent Professionals will be hired. We need Housing Navigators to help find the ZERO units of housing available. These people are also used to convince homeless that concentration camps are "housing", and so is the back seat of an old car. They want you to LIE and say you are a drug addict, an alcoholic, a former criminal, or mentally ill, and THEN you get help. However, they imprison you in some sort of an institution, saying that they found you "housing". In defense of these Useless Professionals, they are mostly recent graduates of universities or graduate schools, and have not YET found out that most of what they were taught was intentionally wrong, to give them a bias in how they handle their professional work. All else is to admit how very intentionally unfair society is. Most of our homeless are on the DNH list, Do Not House, because they angered someone wealthy.

Some of the new state money will go for housing vouchers, and occasionally people find real housing with those. It is usually in rural areas, not the city.

**Solving the homeless issue** in San Diego only requires building a whole lot of apartments that rent for very low prices, exactly what our Redevelopment Authorities tore down. 40 thousand homeless at \$300,000 each equals 12 billion dollars. Since the condo industry downtown makes one or two billion dollars a week, this would only take 6 to 12 weeks to pay for.

Homeless advocate Michael McConnell told NBC news "It's going to take a lot more than this (\$2 billion over 10 years) to solve the issue." Oct. 10, 6:30 PM.

**Editorial: Stupidity Rules:** Developed by Mayor Kevin Faulconer, City Council Member Chris

Ward, and the San Diego Housing Commission, **this “New” homeless plan is an attempt to continue San Diego’s complete ineffectiveness on the homeless situation for long after present perpetrators leave office.** The only people even stupider on the homeless problem are those on the RTFH, Regional Task Force on the Homeless, so there is no way that these plans have any chance of success. Expect a lot more homeless, a lot more excuses, a lot more wasted money, and a lot more lies and propaganda about how many homeless we have and what “housing” is. A cot in a storm sewer? Sure, that’s “housing”, if you live in San Diego. (I need to admit that some voucher programs have worked for a small number of people, but in general **the only thing that has reduced San Diego homelessness the past 20 years is deaths resulting from being homeless.**)

We need a new Mayor, new City Council, new County Board, new representatives in the State Legislature, and we need to disband the Redevelopment Authority, plus the Regional Task Force on the Homeless, and the San Diego Housing Commission. These would be important first steps in beginning to conquer the homeless issue. All else fails to tackle the real estate godfather and his housing cartel.

## Educational Section:

**Since nearly everyone in San Diego that handles the homeless situation is so outrageously STUPID on same, believing the BS they were taught in college, it behooves us to provide some truth in each edition.** If you ever become homeless, you will then know what it’s like to be insulted a thousand times a day, dealing with people who wouldn’t know the truth if it bit them in the ass.

Today’s concept is the **Homeless Rotation**, which now has two different but related meanings. Picture a huge blob of clay, spinning around while proceeding down the sidewalk. These are homeless people, tens of thousands of them, but only those in the blob in contact with the sidewalk are homeless on the sidewalk today. All the rest will have to wait their turn, being on the sidewalk tomorrow. Counts of the homeless only count those on the sidewalk today, not those who got one night in a motel today, nor those who could not be found because they are really good at hiding.

For every homeless person you see, there are about 20 to 50 that you do not see, and cannot find. They all hit the sidewalk eventually, whether they like it or not. None of it has to do with being stupid, or lazy, or not talented, or anything like that. We are as good as you, but eventually become damaged from the process of being on the street at times.

The homeless “Rotate” through the process of sometimes being able to live with friends, sometimes finding a job that pays enough money to pay rent, and sometimes having to sleep in cars or even in parks. Each day is a survival challenge, coming up with a place to sleep, shower, use a restroom, obtain food and water, and stay out of trouble. Some give up, because all you need to afford a motel room is to start selling Fentanyl, right? Welcome to San Diego. The only advantage of selling dope for a living is that it comes with a retirement program called prison. There, you are off the sidewalk for life. Prison is a lot easier than being homeless, because you get an indoor room, food, clothing, drinking water, a shower, a toilet, a blanket, medical care, and much more. They even do your laundry and wash your dishes. We treat our homeless worse than we treat murderers on Death Row.

The Homeless Rotation begins when your boss at work files for bankruptcy. Or, when you become injured and need to go to the hospital because a drunk driver hit your car. Or, your landlord informs you that your \$20 a week hotel room is now going to be gentrified and will cost \$450 a week, an increase in rent of 2250%. That is NOT an exaggeration.

After that, you use whatever retirement income sources you have, to try to pay your rent, eventually running out of money. There are lots of jobs around, but none of them pay enough money to afford your new rent. Could YOU afford a 2,250% rent or house payment increase? You find a storage locker to store your couch, video equipment, kitchen stove, refrigerator, clothing, tools, hobby gear, and the rest of your stuff. Quickly. You check in at the Roach Motel, if you can find a room, and try to get housing with your friends. **If you own a storage locker with all your stuff in it, you are homeless.** Period. This just isn’t your night for having to sleep on the sidewalk. That night will come.

It happens to doctors and lawyers, and the first homeless person I outreached was a life insurance

agent sleeping in his Lincoln Continental car. He had plenty of money, but his landlord threw him out without notice, illegally. One homeless doctor on the streets of San Diego observed that my foot hurt really bad, looked at it, and wrote me a prescription for a narcotic painkiller. The drug store filled that prescription, so he was for real. Medi-Cal paid for it, too.

Imagine being a Phi-Beta-Kappa from Harvard and having your designer sleeping bag under a tree in Balboa Park, with you in it. Eventually the constant insults will leave you with no self-esteem at all, and then you can drink booze, use dope, or kill yourself. The whole process makes people mentally ill in time. You have a job interview tomorrow, but you really stink, so you have taken water out of a Balboa Park display fountain and you go into the forest to wash up. Careful you don’t get arrested for Indecent Exposure or you will have to register as a Sex Offender the rest of your life, and probably never get a job.

The person who interviews you the following day has already done a background check, and informs you that they cannot hire you because you had been homeless and also evicted. You go back to the park and the police are looking for you. You find a shopping cart and move those possessions with you in the park to your rented storage locker. You move into a canyon in North Park. It stinks, there is a lot of garbage, pee, and poop, and nearby homeowners welcome you with shotguns. You didn’t put any of that smelly stuff in the canyon, and you don’t use dope, either. You just started using whiskey. Careful, because they are going to Outreach and Rotate you!

The second meaning of Homeless Rotation is the complete waste of time involved in seeking help that is not there. Every minute of every day, well-meaning complete idiots want to give you help, without realizing that no help exists for most homeless. They want to introduce you to housing programs, drug abatement programs, mental illness programs, employment programs, alcoholism programs, and keep you busy rotating around to thousands of organizations that have nothing at all you qualify for.

You get photographed, fingerprinted, given a cell phone to track your location, swabbed for DNA, and they want to know every detail of your life. You join our San Diego Homeless Data-Base of 75,000 people, in a city that only admits 7,000 homeless. Oh, only 7,000 are homeless tonight, and there will be an entirely different 7,000 on the sidewalk tomorrow night? Yes, that is really how it works.

You have to be careful you do not get rotated into a continuous pattern of visiting thousands of agencies that have no help for you. It is used to keep you too busy to become an activist for the homeless. You will see a Housing Navigator, even though there is not one unit of housing available and has not been any for several years. The Housing Navigator will try to convince you that the back seat of a Buick is “housing”, or try to find you housing that is in another city, such as Chicago or New York. You will get an appointment to apply for Nazi Death Camp housing at San Diego’s several abusive agencies, but you’re in luck: San Diego only has Death Camp housing for about 4,000 people, so that only 10% of our 40,000 homeless fit at any given time. Don’t even get on their 18-year waiting list.

Housing vouchers sometimes work out, if you don’t mind living in a rural area, such as Borrego Springs, plus you are willing to wait 22 years from the time you sign up. If you are severely handicapped, your wait can be as little as 3 months.

In the meantime, you are part of the Homeless Rotation, hitting the sidewalk occasionally, an average of one day out of ten, plus you are part of the other Homeless Rotation, going around endlessly from one help appointment to another, every day, and never qualifying for any help at all. Both of these Rotations continue the rest of your life, and when you finally die, the number of homeless in San Diego goes down by one person, you. You might get some help if you ever get extremely mentally ill, but in general San Diego County only has extremely incompetent and non-helpful services in that area, where clients are tortured ruthlessly to teach them not to claim to be mentally ill. I wrote a fine article on San Diego having no viable mental health treatment.

By now you have graduated from whiskey and you are smoking lots of marijuana, and occasionally using crack cocaine and just a wee bit of heroin. Big Jimmy, the local heroin dealer, has high hopes for you. You can get a free grenade launcher if you buy dope from Jimmy for a long enough time. You have an appointment to go to a Job Fair tomorrow.

You show up in a business suit, and have photos of you in your Harvard fraternity sweater. They ask you if you have ever cooked fast food before, or been a cashier at a convenience store. You haven’t, plus those jobs pay less than the least expensive rent in

San Diego, so there is no employment match for you. They tell you that even though you have an Eviction and a Homeless time period on your record, they could use you to sell soft drinks at Petco Park. You say maybe, but you have a doctor’s appointment tomorrow, to see if you qualify for Medi-Cal or any form of disability income. Maybe in a week or two.

You then have appointments with 3 different church groups who are going to see if they can help you. One of the groups wants to help you find Jesus, and they will give you really bad temporary shelter housing, provided you pray with them 8 hours a day, and then spend another 5 hours soliciting donations from San Diego tourists. You tell them that several religious leaders tried that and are currently in prison for Indentured Servitude, which is also called Slavery. Knowing Jesus shall set you free, but not until the end of your prison sentence.

The free food everybody is giving you is making you extremely sick. You heard that help agencies put their blood in the food in order to hypnotize and brainwash people, and you’re starting to believe it. You can’t think straight, can’t concentrate, and can’t remember anything. It’s really awful. You buy a whole quart of whiskey and it makes you feel okay. Nobody told you that alcoholism is almost always caused by consuming the blood (or semen) of other people, secretly added to hypnotize them. Now, your drinking is interfering with your daily appointments, or is it your appointments that are interfering with your drinking?

A year later, you still have not found any help even though you visited 325 agencies that had nothing for you. You start to smoke crack cocaine every day. You raise the money by breaking into cars. Some days, you even break into houses. The crack, now with meth too, helps you tolerate thousands of insults every day. Big Jimmy the heroin dealer keeps telling you to stop using that pussy stuff and come back to the real deal, heroin.

The police are starting to get upset with you, because you have not yet died, moved away from San Diego, found a job that pays enough money to afford rent, nor have you moved into a Hitler-shelter concentration camp. What’s wrong with you? You finally find a job that pays enough to pay rent, but you are working for a drug cartel selling methamphetamine. Still, it is a job. Gets you out of that continuous Homeless Rotation of hitting the sidewalk, and the other rotation of seeing thousands of nonprofits and government agencies that have nothing at all which will help. In Meth We Trust?

Never mind the retirement perks where you eventually get to spend 60 years in the State Prison System, a retired dope dealer. The Homeless Rotation systems force you to change where you live more often than you get to change your underwear. Prison is stability. Prison is one way used to cut down on the number of San Diego homeless. The other way is death.

If you are homeless in San Diego, 30 die for each one finding housing that is real housing, not a prison or a tent in a storm sewer. The big shocker is that most of us homeless are way more talented and educated than most of the other people in San Diego, who are not homeless.

“I’m from the Civic San Diego redevelopment agency, and we will be increasing your rent from \$20 a week, to \$450 a week. We know this will make you homeless and eventually a junkie, but we have a deal with the Mormon and Jewish godfathers to make them a billion dollars a week profit selling downtown condos via the real estate cartel business. Here is your Eviction Notice, you goddamn homeless scum.”

There. Learning the two basic concepts regarding the Homeless Rotation is the first and most basic lesson in this series of kindergarten for college graduates.

## MEETINGS:

**The Only current** meetings being reported on are those of the Think Dignity family of organizations, due to a decision by the San Diego Homeless Editorial Board that **no other meetings were leading in a direction which might make any difference in the homeless situation.** At one time, we covered meetings of the Homeless Committee of the San Diego City Council, plus meetings of the Council itself. And, at one time, we covered meetings of the RTFH, Regional Task Force on the Homeless, as well as MAPSS, Metropolitan Association of Providers of Social Services. All of these groups are well-intentioned, but deal with non-solutions.

**The Basic Dignity Coalition** of Think Dignity met October 3 with 19 present. A number of important topics were covered, the first of which is San Diego's welfare system:

**Welfare in San Diego County** is now up to \$449 a month, plus a free bus pass for the month and \$194 in Food Stamp benefits. This is paid out as \$643 EBT, and your card can also be used at certain restaurants. You are also allowed free admission to certain museums, and get a few free movie passes, too. You can own up to \$1,000 worth of things plus \$4,650 worth of vehicles, such as a car. You can have a job earning up to \$337 a month. Welfare is a loan which gets repaid when you get a job or receive SSI benefits.

When you go on welfare, San Diego County will help you get federal SSI benefits instead, even giving you an attorney. It takes 3 or 4 months to get SSI, but you are paid about \$1,000 per month from the date you apply, so, you can get a check for over \$3,000. You also get \$200 a month in food stamp benefits, which does not need to be repaid.

If you are over age 65, you automatically get SSI if you apply for it. The amount is about \$1,000 a month, MINUS whatever you get in Social Security. Under age 65, you need to list some sort of disability. There are 3 ways to apply, and you should apply all 3 ways at the same time. When I applied, two of my applications were denied, but the third one came back approved. Apply on-line directly at a federal government website. Second, apply directly to the State of California via going in-person to a federal Social Security office (NOT a state Health and Human Services office). Third, apply to San Diego County via going in-person to a State Health and Human Services office. Denied all 3 ways? Use a free attorney from San Diego County Legal Aid to sue the federal government for your benefits. It could take 3 years, but they have to pay you \$1,000 a month from the time you file, so you might get a check for \$36,000 for 3 years SSI. Three years is the maximum in back benefits. San Diego County does not charge you any money, except you have to pay back the welfare money you borrowed.

I once had to sue SD County for food stamp benefits because they unlawfully denied me same. The courts forced them to pay triple what I was due, and I got a check for \$7,000, so don't give up. I invested the money in my business, Alpine Air Conditioning and Heating, which would not need further government help until the beginnings of the current Second Great Depression, which began in February of 2006 and continues to this day. I was bankrupted in November of 2007, having exhausted all of my retirement savings. This is exactly the way people become homeless in San Diego, and what you may have heard about us being "inferior" is ridiculous. We do get mighty disabled over time, however.

Caution: Going on welfare shows up on your Credit Report, so you might never get housing nor a job the rest of your life. Each county in California has its own program, different from each other county, and not supported by any state nor local programs.

**Voices of Dignity** is setting up focus groups and continuing advocacy efforts. The current Failure Rate among homeless entering housing programs is 27% who drop out after a program is found for them. Why? Is it the fault of the homeless enrolled, or were they enrolled in the wrong program, or are our homeless housing programs that awful? Currently our housing programs are program-centric, not client-centric, so we start a program and then look who fits it. **Most current homeless fit NO current program.** We need programs that fit clients, not clients that fit programs.

San Diego has criminalized being homeless as much as it can. If it cannot arrest you for being on the sidewalk, it will arrest you for having your tent or backpack on the sidewalk, instead. And, the city makes sure there are no toilets nor trash receptacles for you to use, and then arrests you for human wastes and trash being discarded into the street, as if you have any choice. Alternative camp solutions need to be developed, as well as a new vehicle parking-living ordinance and more parking lots for homeless living in vehicles. There is a need for one thousand new storage units, in addition to the 900 which already exist. Some MTS transit policies need to be changed. Homeless need to be able to purchase low-cost or no-cost bus passes.

Voices of Dignity is also conducting advocacy training every Monday, holding and attending press conferences, and attempting to craft a new Vehicle Habitation Ordinance. They also attend RTFH (Regional Task Force on the Homeless) meetings and County Board meetings.

**On the Legal Front,** San Diego has settled with our attorney, Scott Dreher, regarding the Encroachment Citations, a new storage facility with 500 new bins, and a new police code to handle ticketing of homeless. When you refuse to be Outreached because that led to not getting any services the past 800 times you were Outreached, and the Gestapo Agents who Outreached you now call the police, the police have new rules:

**They can do nothing to you the first time you refuse to become Rotated** (see "Homeless Rotation", the most important single concept of understanding the truth about homelessness, IN THIS EDITION). The second time you refuse Rotation, they can issue you an Infraction ticket. Infractions do not lead to jail time, unless you do not appear in court at the date and time indicated. A third refusal of being Rotated will result in a ticket for a Misdemeanor, which results in a trial and can result in your going to jail or prison, so you need a lawyer. Your fourth refusal to be Rotated results in your immediate arrest.

**Homeless and Poverty Needs Commodity Distribution** is planned for Sunday, Dec. 8, 9-11 AM, at 14<sup>th</sup> and J, which is Fault-Line Park. Tarps, sleeping bags, winter tents, winter clothing, and pet supplies are being sought so they can be given out to those in need.


