Toilets Still a Major Problem

Public Indecency? Per signs at 12th and Imperial, the City of San Diego intends to criminally charge those who need to urinate and cannot find toilets with the sex-crime of "Public Indecency". Isn't the City, in not having enough toilets, a PTC (Party To a Crime) for causing the lack of toilets? How can the City charge other people criminally for a problem it creates?

The **Mayor's Committee to Prevent Downtown Toilets** shows its true colors: With the removal of one of the Portland Loo toilets, we now have fewer toilets downtown than at any time in the past 20 years. And, while consistently promising more toilets, we get fewer and fewer instead. Why? San Diego wants to arrest those with a need to urinate and/or defecate for the Sex Crime of "Public Indecency" (see photo, above right). **Isn't the City a co-conspirator (PTC = Party To a Crime) in all this?** Legal precedents already exist which have determined that the homeless need toilets, and in cities without sufficient of same, **we have the right to toilet** on the sidewalks. Think-Tanks:

The Metropolitan Association of Providers of Social Services (MAPPS) met Wed., Feb. 24, with 27 present. This group meets the Fourth (not Last) Wednesday of each month (except Nov. and Dec.) at the First Lutheran Church, 3rd Ave. at Ash St., Downtown San Diego, 10 AM. • **Announcements:** Recovery Innovations International has moved to 3838 Camino del Rio-N. and will be getting a new telephone number. • Amikas has a property near Father Joe's that may be suitable for the new "tiny houses" program. • Escondido now has a welfare enrollment office at County FRC on Washington Avenue. • YWCA is now hiring bilingual case managers. • Second Chance will be having an April 5 jobs and resources faire. • Salvation Army Door of Hope has several vacant apartments for single women without children, and is accepting applications for those with children, a 3 month wait. • Most Rapid Rehousing providers are now all out of money. • **Presentations:** **Cal-Fresh**, also known as Food Stamps, SNAP, and many other names which vary by state, is available by calling "211". Most folks do not know that several laws concerning military families, criminal convictions, child support payments, and all sorts of other things were all thrown out by the legal system. Criminal convictions are okay. All you need is to legally live in San Diego and have a Social Security Number. • The other presentation was for **CIE, Community Information Exchange**. This is a data network sharing social service agency and healthcare information to make a unified client record. It has 5200 clients who consented to share data in a "trust network". Automatic sharing includes the Sheriff's Booking Log, and various hospital, healthcare, medical records, jail records, ambulance use, and more. This system is used by HOT (San Diego Police Homeless Outreach Team) to find people, too. All those sharing data agree to keep it secret from unauthorized persons. I raised the objection that if data is abused, vulnerable persons are usually not able to sue for damages. Also, using the Secret Societies (such as the Cabals), **former homeless are routinely denied employment and housing for having once been homeless**. Anything that can be abused will be. What is even worse, "211" is keeping this data-base, so many folks may not even be able to ask for

help when they need it. If you ask for help, you can be labeled a “Troublemaker” and added to the Blackball Lists, such as the DNE (Do Not Employ) or DNH (Do Not House) lists of the Secret Societies of the Bar-Mafia. • The evaluation of January’s StreetLinks presentation on Mental Health services was delayed until next month, Wed., Mar. 23, 10 AM, First Lutheran Church, 3rd and Ash, Downtown San Diego. ♦♦♦♦♦

The Coalition For Basic Dignity - San Diego (CBDSD) met March 3, (First Thursday of each month at 6 PM), at their **new location, 705 N. 16th St.,** Downtown San Diego, as guests of the Girls Think Tank, which is now called “Think Dignity”. 16 were present. Excellent ideas at this meeting, and minimal propaganda. • There was a “Reclaim Unsafe Space” project in Logan Heights, so why not one in East Village (“The Bottoms Ghetto”, our downtown homeless area)? • Crocheting socks to fit over construction cranes was mentioned. (Too many artists jumping off the Coronado Bridge). • One woman was raped in the Portland Loo that was removed, about 6 months ago, according to a Spokesperson for Father Joe’s Villages. He also said that all of the toilets at Fault Line Park (the really tall building near 14th and Island Ave.) were removed or closed due to crime. • Girls Think Tank said it intended to help to decriminalize homelessness. • Computer classes specifically for the homeless were suggested. • A store similar to the Latrobe Store in Melbourne, Australia, was suggested. • To help with the transportation problem, a bike repair shop or person was suggested, since MTS intends to increase fees soon for the bus and trolley. • It was pointed out that the new location for homeless services, about 14th and Commercial, might not be a good location. • The “Tiny Houses” solution has worked in Madison, Wisconsin, to solve its homeless problem (see editorial, above.) •

A man whom I identified as a **Spokesperson for Father Joe’s Villages**, due to his previous representation at other meetings, said that the homeless want to feel that they have contributed something to the community. We agree. He also stated that homelessness is a major cause of mental illness, and we also agree. Then he went on to say that the homeless want to “find leaders” and want a “mentor” or “natural leader” to guide them, teach them what to believe, and how to behave. **Wrong!** We vehemently disagree. Following bullshit teachings and phony beliefs is how people got to be homeless to begin with. **People are homeless by believing and following these “natural teachers or leaders” and want absolutely no more of all that propaganda and religion.** He praised the Downtown Partnership (Civic San Diego – Clean and Safe) propaganda hand-out about religion and similar useless services information, which I compare to the bull that is listed at the “Jim Crow” Entrance (toilets) to City Hall. Idiotic nonsense. **All of this propaganda and all of these lies help to perpetuate homelessness, not help it.**

Hints and Kinks:

Could folks losing their housing be “outreached” with solutions, before the homeless experience makes them mentally unstable drug abusers? Money for mental health treatment misses the point that much less damage occurs with proactive intervention. That’s what both “Rapid Rehousing” and “Housing First” are all about. Emergency Shelters, too? Okay, but we have too much emphasis on teaching and training (because there is a lot of money for that) and on mental illness (ditto on the money). The person themselves does not apparently weigh into this equation, just the money to be made. Homeless need job placement, not training, so how about a Self-Employment bureau? Most of our homeless in San Diego are on the DNE black-ball list (Do Not Employ), so finding a job is for them next to impossible.

Ideas:

How about a **Nonprofit that gives 100% of the money it collects directly to the homeless?** Minimal overhead, all labor donated, which is one part-time bookkeeper. Ten times the effectiveness for your donated money. If you did not sweat to earn money, it was just given to you, then you do not properly value it? You mean sort of like inheriting?

Improve transit efficiency by having all the **bus and trolley approaches turn the traffic signals green for them.** Police, fire, ambulances would also have the signal boxes that can do that. Digital code changed daily, automatically, via a longwave radio receiver. Traffic signals are linked in via the electric power lines they are connected to.

How about a **homeless-operated restaurant**, like HomeQuest (years ago) providing both food and employment?

How about a **homeless convenience store**, or at least coffee vending machines?

Mini-houses for both sleeping and storage at the same time.

A nonprofit that helps the homeless obtain **employment**, not training, not job training, only job interviews.
