I have worked with several, including Red Cross and American Cancer Society. Does your group help the poor and/or homeless? Good. **Do you make any permanent differences, or does it all go away when you do?** Our criteria address the 6 branches of our government: Legislative, Executive, Judicial, Press, Religion, and Banking.

1. How has your group enabled the passage of new laws giving more privileges, more rights, and an easier life for the homeless? (Legislative)
2. How has your group caused law enforcement regarding the poor and homeless to be increasingly fair, honest, and transparent? (Executive)
3. How has your group fought in the legal system for homeless rights, damages, injunctions, court orders and/or similar? (Judicial)
4. How has your group caused a better understanding of the homeless, their situation, their needs, the truths and realities of the problem? (Press)
5. How has your group helped to abate the religious slavery, abuses of Spirituality, religious propaganda, and other uses of religion to control the poor and homeless rather than to truly help them? (Religion)
6. How has your group helped to fund the above groups and organizations? (Banking)
