Our Biggest Problems

Storage, Transportation, Spirituality, Harassment

A course in Homelessness in San Diego, Psychology 303, at the College Junior-Senior Level, by Dr. John Kitchin, Milwaukee Free University

Part One: Causes of Homelessness, Contributing Factors, and Effects Upon the Individual and Society

Homelessness is caused by housing costing more than people can afford to pay. Recession, economic Depression, unemployment, lack of jobs, and other economic troubles exacerbate this. So does gentrification, redevelopment, neighborhood improvement, and real estate price-fixing. Once a person cannot afford to pay for their present housing, or it gets upgraded out of their economic reach, they become homeless. Their possessions become lost or stolen, or placed into storage, and their living condition may become worse than a refugee camp, and their situation hopeless. Once homeless, many commit suicide, while others eventually become alcoholics, drug addicts, mentally ill, religious sheep, and/or criminals. Making all matters worse are the nonprofit organizations, which preach false hope, media feel-good propaganda, and making people feel good about donating time or money that ends up doing no good, except to generate publicity for the nonprofit, so that they can get more grants and donations. Nonprofits make money on the situation getting worse. And, let us not forget about Cookies. **Cookies:**

"Once there was a man who had cancer. His HMO refused to treat it, because that would be too expensive. So, he asked the government for help, and they gave him a bandage to put over it, so no one would notice. He then

asked the nonprofits for help, and they gave him a **cookie** to make him feel better. This is how society treats its **problem of homelessness.**" Nonprofits give out lots of cookies, in one way or another, and none of those cookies really benefit anyone except the nonprofit, and its directors, who may get additional trips to fun resorts and junkets to Las Vegas.

A myriad of programs, none of which prevent homelessness nor treat the problems it causes until they have done their damage, exist. **Once mentally ill or a substance abuser, GAME OVER.** Then society must start providing food, housing, medical and other care for life, with no attempt to have the person hold a job. Exceptions? I am certain there are 5 persons who have successfully been rehabilitated, and I am also certain that you will insist about broadcasting their fake success stories to everyone on the whole planet, at full volume. You are not willing to tell the whole story, though, that these were special deals for special people, related to those famous or politically powerful.

The so-called "Affordable" Housing helps for those with jobs under the \$32 an hour that the United States Dept. of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) says that you need to earn to live in San Diego. It does not help, however, the disabled, other handicapped, nor the military veterans who are scarred from their military service. It also does not help the unemployed nor under-employed. They chug booze, eat "holy" hypnotic drugged foods at every meal, piss and shit on your sidewalk, get harassed just for existing to the point of eventually hating everyone, and suffer a huge amount of trauma every day from continual insults, demeaning behavior towards them, religious propaganda and lies, contaminated foods, a lack of toilets, lack of storage space, difficulties obtaining showers and washing clothes, long waits in many lines, lawyers and tickets, harassment by police and security guards, and a Downtown San Diego Lifestyle that United Nations Inspectors have condemned as worse than almost any of the refugee camps on the entire planet. **These are refugees made homeless by our Real Estate system!**

FEMA, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, recognizes that homeless caused by an earthquake are just as homeless as those caused by unfair housing prices, so they help out with this "Economic Disaster". This disaster was not caused by nature, however. Storms, flooding, and earthquakes did not make these folks homeless. Real estate and banking, along with local government zoning and Eminent Domain use did. If someone caused a terrible disaster, making a lot of people homeless, using a weather machine that caused a tornado, would they be prosecuted? And, would FEMA help clean up the mess? Of course it would. What if instead of a weather machine, they used a group of banks, real estate appraisers, and real estate sales agents? It is time we seek out and prosecute the perpetrators of this Economic Disaster that is costing so much money! Iceland is sending its Prime Minister, most of its bankers, and most of its real estate agents to prison.

So much for the cause of homelessness, and now on to Part Two, its immediate needs, and then on to some solutions.

Part Two: Problems For the Individual, and Corresponding Problems for Society.

So, **inability to afford whatever housing is available** causes homelessness. This problem is purely economic and has the elements of income and housing prices, plus a whole lot of politics that goes into both. The problems that homelessness creates are two types, **Problems For the Individual**, and also **Problems For Society**.

STORAGE: Individuals have the problem of not being able to store what they own, not even legal papers, the burial urns of their parents, birth certificates, manuscripts, spare underwear and other clothing, blankets, tools, and more. And, alternatively, how do they transport this stuff to store it, or how do they carry it around with them? **Society inherits the problem** of mountains

of belongings, important only to one or a few people, accumulating on streets, sidewalks, and in alleys and parks. And, society also has the problem of large amounts of belongings being carted all over on the bus and trolley system, as well as in shopping carts and via other means.

TRANSPORTATION: Homeless have no means of getting to job interviews, getting to and from whatever storage places may exist, getting to meals and/or other food sources, getting to medical appointments, getting to courts and attorneys offices, getting to help meetings, or even getting to a park or beach to rest or recreate. **Society's corresponding problem** is that money for the bus or trolley must be panhandled, plus homeless tend to accumulate in areas where all needed services are within walking distance, plus they may end up in front of your home or business instead of being at a park, recreation area, playground, or beach. This is a problem of transportation, plus the lack of suitable other places to be nearby. Society also has the problem of homeless not showing up for a doctor appointment, and thus taxpayers end up paying for more expensive medical procedures, as well as not showing up for a court date, so taxpayers have additional legal, court, police, and jail expenses. Not being able to get to a job or a job interview costs society whatever work could have been done by the homeless person, plus whatever tax money would have been collected from that work, and society must pay money to maintain that homeless person in their non-working state with things like food, clothing, and government taxpayer money used by nonprofit organizations. Lack of homeless transportation is extremely expensive for society. Having people sleep on your street overnight is a transportation problem, because they would much rather be out in a forest or in the mountains somewhere, but how?

Having your stuff in a shopping cart: Storage Problem.

Having to be in front of a bank, instead of in a park or the mountains of East County: Transportation Problem.

Part Three: The Problem of Spirituality and Tainted Food

Eating human DNA (usually blood or semen secretly added to food by nonprofit organizations and/or churches) results in mental illness, reduced sex drive, difficulty focusing and concentrating, sexual difficulties and dysfunction, lower self-esteem, memory problems, attention span problems, difficulties with interpersonal relationships, laziness, trouble sleeping, increased discomfort from smaller pains and/or itches, fewer dreams and of lesser quality, motivational difficulties, emotional distress, increased gullibility, unfounded trust, difficulties telling lies from truth, addiction to religion or the bible, and often causes other problems such as drug abuse, alcoholism, criminal behavior, or suicide. It also makes people easy to control, hypnotize, socialize, and brainwash. That is why the Nonprofit Organizations all use it, without exception, in the free food given to the poor and homeless (based upon current research). Unfortunately, it causes those problems listed. All food you buy contains DNA (human blood and/or semen) added to it already, but it is a very small amount. Some of the local organizations add way too much, causing way many problems as a result. The 14-year-old high-schoolers serving at Father Joe's discuss how much of their blood is in the food. We need to assemble a committee on how to abate Spirituality Abuse. **How do we expect people to "get better" and "get a life" when we are sabotaging their lives thru their food? Meetings

The Emergency Resource Group, ERG, met Tues., Dec. 3, with 11 present (It is holiday time and also the deadline date for FEMA funding papers). There will be NO Jan. meeting. • The Downtown Storage Area, operated by Girls Think Tank (GTT) must move by early in January. • All tent shelters, both the Barrio Logan general shelter and the Midway Area veterans shelter must close by March 31. • All shelters are accessed by calling "211" from any phone. • Almost all nonprofits have job openings right now, including some high-paid positions. Turnover has been unbelievable. • The Mayors Office Advisors assisting the homeless under Mayor Filner have been terminated by Interim Mayor Todd Gloria, leading to many homeless now lacking help from the City. • Little or no help was available for Thanksgiving food for poor families. • The Mayoral election is in February. • In the absence of Mayor Filner, police have again been out of control and so have Transit Security and Private Security. • The Point-In-Time Count is January 24 this coming year. Last year's count was over 50% off because of leaflets printed by the Lincoln Club and distributed by the College Republicans advising homeless to temporarily be somewhere else, well-hidden, to avoid police arrest on that day, the count day, to avoid a long prison term. • The low count last year has unfortunately deprived the City and County of San Diego of millions of dollars to deal with our ever-expanding homeless problem. • It was mentioned that crowds of people needing food and housing are now at record-high levels, and have doubled in the past few months. **How's THAT for optimism! ♦♦♦♦ The Girls Think Tank (GTT) met Thursday, Dec. 5, with** 21 present, which included 7 attorneys, an engineer, an office manger, 4 homeless intellectuals, one government official, a community leader, and 3 high school children who started a nonprofit to feed the homeless, the "Burrito Boys". Three others also present, status unknown. • It was mentioned that there has been very poor coordination among nonprofits, resulting in several trying to do exactly the same thing on the same street corner at the same time, and

Bruce Menser of the Downtown Fellowship on 3rd Ave. is attempting to resolve this issue. • The City has been taking steps to prevent food distribution and help mentoring at 13th and K, also 14th and L. • The Port Commission is looking to attract federal funds for its homeless problem in the harbor area, and is seeking a spokesperson for the homeless. • GTT will hold a fund raising event at the new Downtown Central Library on Sat., May 31. More info at www.GirlsThinkTank.Org. • Storage facility on Commercial St. is closing by Jan. 10 and a new site is sought. Talks ongoing with the Acting Mayor, Housing Commission, City Attorney, Downtown Partnership, and possibly BOMA and/or IPOA (Building Owners Management Association and Income Property Owners Association). • The Toilet Task Force (Mayor's Task Force on Public Restrooms) meets Dec. 10. The toilets on 17th and Island are supposed to be moved to 14th and Imperial, although the Downtown Partnership (Clean and Safe) is objecting to all locations. The Portland Loos Project for 11th and Market toilets is proceeding, but the 14th and L location has funding problems. No word on the toilets in Little Italy. **How about a Class Action Suit giving homeless the right to excrete wastes anywhere Downtown, in full view of the public, until the City puts in more toilets?** • The presentation today is on the Burrito Boys, a nonprofit organization called Hunger To Help. 6:30 to 8:30 AM every Sunday, a group of high school students distributes burritos on 13th and Market. Starting with 4,000 several years ago, distribution is now 25,000 and a budget of \$40,000 a year. Taco Bell recently donated \$5,000 to the cause. www.BurritoBoyz.Org. • Roman Nowicki of the Veterans Administration has a new Homeless Veterans Outreach program, operating with Aware Recycling (San Diego Rescue Mission Recycling, 14th and Market St.) that also operates with Clean and Safe. The objective is to find those veterans who are not aware of the NEW housing programs, and help them. • **No meeting in January ♦♦♦♦ MAPSS, the Metropolitan Association of Providers of Social Services met Wed. Dec. 18,** a week ahead of the usual time, to avoid meeting on Christmas, with 11 present, and discussed problems with the **Page Six**

breakup of LIHP (Low Income Health Program) and CMS (County Medical Services). • The Resource Faire will be held March 19, 2014, 1-3 PM at Father Joe's, 15th and Imperial Ave. • The next meeting will be Jan. 22, with a report from Mental Health Systems, which has an office in the new Downtown library. • The Feb. meeting will feature TACO, the Third Ave. Charitable Org. • Since GTT and ERG do not meet in Jan., this will be the only Social Service Provider meeting that we regularly cover that is scheduled. • Project Homeless Connect on Dec. 4 helped 950 people, a bit down from last year. Storage and Transportation remain the biggest problems for the poor. • Many subsidized living and housing programs are currently available that have available space for new tenants. Dial "211" from any phone. • It was discussed that ERG may want to merge with MAPSS, but all speaking on that issue were in favor of not doing that. More discussion at future meetings. Primary objections to merging the orgs had to do with diversity of times and meeting places being a plus, the different perspectives and topics dealt with by the two groups, and 80% do not attend both meetings now. • (§ Xmas Street Edition)

Girls Think Tank, Reevaluated

I am reevaluating my relationship with the Girls Think Tank, having been repeatedly insulted the past several months. One such group of insults got an apology, but the apology contained an insult. How sincere! As a homeless, I am accustomed to being insulted at least a hundred times a day, but not generally by groups that I provide ideas for. It is true that both MAPSS (Metropolitan Association of Providers of Social Services) and ERG (Emergency Resources Group) initially insulted me, but not in recent times. I have come up with ideas for them, too.

It is hard to understand how an organization can be for "Basic Dignity" and yet be so pompous, self-righteous, and arrogant. I see the same "Us Versus Them" mentality in the GTT as elsewhere, "We are wonderful people who are so nice that we help you slime of the earth." Well, if your parents were switched with mine at birth, you would be on the sidewalk yourself right now. Wealth is seldom earned, often inherited. How does any of this make you "better than" anyone else? In your OWN MIND? Is having Professional Privilege helping you to "re-arrange" the truth, so that you are happy with yourself? You guys are a Psychologist's nightmare.

I had always considered myself a peer intellectually to this group of attorneys and community leaders, but I now find that I am way more intelligent. How sad! I had hope that there was some shred of decency and intelligence somewhere. My prognosis for the need for World War Three proves true, and that will take a mutiny in the military. I should by rights be angry, but I am smiling and amused by it all. You could call me a perfect example of stupidity, because I have always shared what I have, and where has that gotten me?

I get certain undeniable conclusions out of it all. The nonprofits have not the foggiest idea of what homelessness is all about. And, they accept my ideas and use them, but will neither accept me nor take me seriously. Okay. There is a huge effort to silence me, too. Okay. If my opinions are without merit, is silencing me necessary? It cannot be escaped that a large number of these professionals are far less intelligent than I am, and that makes them uncomfortable. Me, too. Okay.

Melanie Stuart, one homeless intellectual, gave up on GTT after 3 years deep inside the org, saying they were full of lies, and did not really care about the homeless, just being in it for the money and Public Service credits towards Bar License renewal. Okay. I hung in there, trying to see benefit, and did. I was afraid that if they ever got major funding they might regress into rich bastards, but one must allow that to happen before one can say that for sure.

I am sure that a lot of these things were calculated to make me angry, hoping that I would do something rash, as GTT has tried to get rid of me ever since I exposed its use of insults years ago. I agreed with Melanie that they were fake, but what nonprofit isn't? I had experience with Red Cross and the American Cancer Society, and knew that ALL nonprofits are fake, but must never admit it. There are many reasons to own a nonprofit, but none of them have to do with really helping the situation that you are supposedly fixing. It is ministry, much like religious teachings where a minister that knows better than to believe in God uses hypnosis to force you to believe. Nonprofits hypnotize people into believing that a whole lot is being done to help, even though that is not true. The news media help.

Should GTT be singled out? They are one of the BEST nonprofits, in a long line of corrupt, useless, and worthless organizations. They should be proud to be only 1% as awful as is the norm. I helped to secure them a major grant, and will to continue to advocate them as a stellar nonprofit, even as they continue to insult me for being too intelligent for my station in life. I rejected law as a profession due to same being far too corrupt. Mistake? I do not regret ANY decision I ever made in my life, and how many people can say that? Watch Out For Jim Crowe!

STARBUCKS BRINGS JIM CROWE TO VENICE BEACH

I ran up the sidewalk to the Starbucks on Navy & Main near Venice Beach, California. It was still dark out at 6:10 AM, but I had to get to my new job with the Salvation Army. I'd been sleeping on the sidewalk nearby for the last few months, homeless. I'd lost my job through no fault of my own at the height of the great recession. Inside, I put my huge double sleeping-bag pack under the table where I usually sat. Though a straight-A from the University of Delaware, I definitely "looked homeless." I walked up to the counter and ordered my usual sausage sandwich, grande coffee and LA times when the new manager there, a white girl called Rebecca informed me that my status as a Starbucks customer had

changed. She told me that because of a "hygiene issue" that from now on I would be buying their products there but that I had to immediately leave the store--I could no longer sit with the rest of the patrons. Time stopped. She was not reserving the right to refuse service--she was making my patronage of a Starbucks restaurant conditional as condescendingly and tritely as if she was explaining to "colored" at the counter at Woolworth's in Greensboro, North Carolina in 1960 that that was "just the way it is."

Though I'm white, from an affluent family, a highly educated and articulate Phi Beta Kappa because I "looked homeless" she tried to inform me that I and other "homeless" individuals would be adhering to this Jim Crowe-style condition in the future. It was how things were going to be when I returned and was starting right away—I could buy Starbucks, Inc. product, but I had to immediately leave.

The Jim Crowe laws were racial segregation laws enacted in the U.S. between 1876 and 1965. Most of them were overruled by the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and the Voting Rights Act of 1965. Laws such as: blacks couldn't drink from the same water fountains as whites, blacks had curfews, that blacks could spend their money in "white" restaurants, but there'd be conditions such as they had to enter through the back door or they could order to-go, but they couldn't actually sit with the other patrons. Some of the most hated, blatantly racist, adhorent laws ever enacted--and Rebecca the manager of a Starbucks on the Venice/Santa Monica border was using the same reasoning to clear the "homeless looking" people from her store.

I'd never experienced discrimination before personally in my life, never, but there was only one word for what I began experiencing from that moment on. Rage. Burning, seething, caustic rage. I refused her "conditions" and went down the street to the other Starbucks and spoke to the manager there:, a young Latino girl, as nice as could be. When I explained the conditions that Rebecca had stated earlier, she was flabbergasted. Refuse service, sure, but to tell someone that their money was good but that after they paid that they weren't a full customer? With most "homeless looking" people actually being people of color what could be more racist, more discriminatory. Flash back to 1960 in North Carolina. The similar dynamic was in play back then as Rebecca was trying to initiate in 2013. White restaurants definitely wanted blacks' money. Blacks might constitute 30% or 40% of a small restaurant's revenue, just like the homeless make up a great deal of business in this equation--but with Jim Crowe there were always "the conditions."

Enter Starbucks, Inc.--under analogous pressures due to the crimes of the banks the homeless population of LA and other cities has swollen to crises proportions. When you're homeless you learn the faces of who's homeless from the homeless centers and churches. You see them "out in the world" later in the day and maybe they look homeless--sometimes not. Many live out of their cars. The first thing I began noticing after I became homeless myself was just how many people at the library--and at inexpensive restaurants like Starbucks--were homeless. The homeless are big business to Starbucks, Inc., but there is NEVER an excuse to bring back second-class status to any American under such circumstances. Refuse service, sure.

Refuse dignity to any human being, never. Occupy!

**Merry Christmas, Happy New Year, all
the same day, More Jewish & Pagan
than Christian**

Christmas is also called Yule or New Year and has been celebrated for ten thousand years, as the Winter Solstice, the shortest day of the year, and then the new solar year begins. Christmas means "Gathering of the Anointed One" and involved a celebration to honor the King or Queen (or Emperor). The solstice moves one day earlier every 150 years or so, and was on Dec. 31 years ago when our calendar was formed. By 1300 AD, when the Council of the Nazarene decided to eliminate hundreds of books from the Christian bible, the day for Winter Solstice, Yule, had moved to Dec. 25, and they named the Christian Messiah after the Pagan holiday, calling him Jesus "Christ" as in "Christmas". This would be

calling Jesus the Anointed One, or the King. He was born March 21, 4 BC.

The Christmas tree is Pagan Viking and Norse, the cookies Dutch and Danish, the food is English, Irish, German, French, and Scandinavian, and the tree lights are Jewish, from Hanukkah, the Festival of Lights. The Jews celebrated Christmas in the time of Abraham, so Christmas is also Ancient Jewish.
